2010 TREE SEEDLING SALE**

The Lehigh County Conservation District is again holding its annual tree seedling sale to offer landowners, homeowners, and other individuals the opportunity to improve and protect the environment while beautifying and increasing the value of their property. Proceeds of the sale are used to fund educational programs conducted by the Lehigh County Conservation District. The variety of tree seedlings and seeds being offered was selected to provide a wide variety of uses, and can be grown under a variety of conditions. All tree seedlings are bare root seedlings. Please note that while the District makes every effort to ensure tree health, we do not offer any guarantees.

**American Arborvitae** (*Thuja occidentalis*): 3 years old. 8"-16". Prefers a semi-moist site: deep moist loam in well drained soil but will tolerate sandy soils with high water table. Partial to full sun. Younger trees are columnar and become more pyramidal over time. Useful as hedges, screens, windbreaks. Can reach heights of 30 to 50 feet and widths of 10 to 15 feet. **10 seedlings per bundle.**

**Concolor Fir** (*Abies concolor*): 3 years old. 7"-14". Evergreen. 30 to 50 feet in height by 15 to 30 feet in spread with 1 1/2" needles. Can reach 100 feet. Slow to medium growth rate. Can tolerate heat, drought and poor soils except heavy clay. Popular Christmas tree species. **10 seedlings per bundle.**

**Douglas Fir** (*Pseudotsuga menziesii glauca*): 3 years old. 10"-20". Winter hardy, good ornamental. Most popular Christmas tree. Soft, short green needles. Grows fastest in fertile, well-drained soil. Do not plant in frost pockets. Grows 6 feet in 7 to 8 years. Can attain heights to 100 feet. **10 seedlings per bundle.**

**Eastern White Pine** (*Pinus strobus*): 4 years old. 10"-20". Soft bluish-green needles, 3 to 5 inches. Grows well in most average to moist soils. Excellent ornamental if sheared light. Also good windbreak and timber species. Can grow more than 100 feet in height. **10 seedlings per bundle.**

**Norway Spruce** (*Picea abies*): 3 years old. 10"-24". Short green needles, more rapid growth than Blue Spruce. Excellent for ornamental, screens, windbreaks and Christmas trees. Can attain a height of 100 feet. Does well in most soil. **10 seedlings per bundle.**

**American Cranberry Bush** (*Viburnum trilobum*): 2 years old. 5"-15". Use for screening up to 10 to 12 feet, width of 8 feet. Dense growth up to 3' per year in full sun or part shade. Showy white flowers in spring, red berries in fall/winter. Berries make excellent bird feed. Very few insect problems. Prefers good, well-drained soil. For best growth, water during drought periods. For a solid screen, plant bushes 2'-3' apart. **5 seedlings per bundle.**

**Arrowwood** (*Viburnum dentatum*): 2 years old. 6"-12". Dense, multi-stemmed shrub typically 5' to 9' tall and wide but can be as tall as 15'. Overall shape is rounded. Fruit is blue-black and enjoyed by birds. Very easy to grow. Full sun to partial shade. Soil adaptable from dry to fairly wet. **5 seedlings per bundle.**

**Black Cherry** (*Prunus serotina*): 2 years old. 20"-30". One of the largest cherry trees. Valuable for lumber, cherries often used for jelly. Good for wildlife habitat. Flowers white in May-June, fruits June-October. Rapid growth rate. Prefers deep, moist, fertile soil. Full sun to part shade and is also drought tolerant. **5 seedlings per bundle.**

**Black Chokeberry** (*Aronia melanocarpa*): 2 years old. 10"-20". A low growing spreading shrub with numerous stems. Height can range from 3'-6' tall. An extremely hardy and adaptable shrub for all seasons. Best used as a backdrop for low-growing perennials or groundcovers in formal, tight spaces. The spring, whitish-pink flowers appear in clusters. The fall fruit is 1/4" in diameter. **5 seedlings per bundle.**

**Red Oak** (*Quercus rubra*): 2 years old. 6"-12". Large, fast-growing tree for lawns and open areas. Grows 60 to 75 feet in height with a spread of 40 to 50 feet. Dark green foliage varies between russet-red and bright red in autumn. Produces acorns attracting birds and wildlife. Prefers well-drained sandy loam soils. **5 seedlings per bundle.**

**Silky Dogwood** (*Cornus amomum*): 2 years old. 10"-20". Multi-stemmed, heights 6' to 10' tall. Width is similar to height. Fast growth rate. Birds enjoy the showy blue fruit. Prefers moist, fertile soil and full sun to partial shade. Landscape uses: wet sites, naturalized areas, massing or grouping, border and difficult sites. **5 seedlings per bundle.**

**Sugar Maple** (*Acer saccharum*): 2 years old. 8"-18". One of the best large shade trees. Slow to medium growth rate, 75-100' in height. May have orange or red fall color. Yellow flowers. Prefers well-drained, moderately moist, fertile soil. Although shade tolerant, full sun needed for proper development. **5 seedlings per bundle.**

**White Oak** (*Quercus alba*): 2 years old. 8"-18". Rounded, broad-rounded or upright rounded when mature. Height: 60 to 80' tall. One of the most attractive oaks. Slow-growing. Small, elongated acorns. Prefer full sun, acidic soil. Showy, purple-red long lasting foliage. **5 seedlings per bundle.**

**Winterberry** (*Ilex verticillata*): 2 years old. 5"-12". Multi-stemmed shrub generally 6' to 10' tall. Male and female plants. Birds eat the fruit on female plants. Fruit is bright red and glossy, held well into winter. Full sun to partial shade; more sun means more fruit on females. Tolerant of poorly-drained soils but prefers moist, acidic soils. **5 seedlings per bundle.**

**Blueberries - Blueray and Bluecrop** (*Vaccinium corymbosum*): 2-3 years old. 12"-18". Space plants 6 to 8 feet apart, in rows spaced 8 to 10 feet apart. These upright shrubs will grow to a height of 4 feet. **IMPORTANT NOTE:** For blueberries, fruit set and crop size are improved by cross pollination. Plant both Blueray and Bluecrop for best results. Bare Root seedlings. **Plants are sold individually.**

**NE Annual & Perennial Wildflower Mix:** A beautiful mix that may provide up to 5 years of color and attracts many varieties of birds and butterflies. Some of the seeds contained in this mix are: Bachelor's Button, Shasta Daisy, Black-Eyed Susan and Purple Coneflower. 1 oz. bags will cover approximately 125 sq. ft. **23 varieties in 1 oz. bags.**

**Showy NE Native Wildflower Mix with Grasses:** A perennial mix that will provide color, texture and will attract a variety of wildlife. Some seeds in this mix are: Big Bluestem, Early Goldenrod, Grey and Early Goldenrod, Wild Blue Lupine, Black-Eyed Susan and Indiangrass. 1 oz. bags will cover approximately 125 sq. ft. **23 varieties in 1 oz. bags.**
